# **MUSIC THERAPY EQUIVALENCY PROGRAM**

This program is open to persons holding a bachelor's degree in music but not in music therapy. This equivalency program usually requires approximately 1.5 years of study and permits students to complete required American Music Therapy Association Coursework and a six-month clinical internship.
