The FSUCard is your official:

- University I.D. Card
- Campus access to residence halls, Seminole Dining Account, campus recreation, etc.
- Library card to check-out books and other materials
- And more!

Reasons to come visit the FSUCard Office:

- Get your first time card
- Get a new replacement card
- Learn about services available with your **FSUCard**
- Sign up for a meal plan with Seminole Dining
- Register for parking permits, passes, and citation appeals with FSU Transportation and Parking Services
- Shop for books, apparel and merchandise at the FSU Bookstore & Computer Store

What to Bring:

- Photo identification (valid driver's license, military ID, or current passport) when visiting the **FSUCard Center** for your **first** card.
- Your EMPLID or FSUID Number (To locate your EMPLID sign in to my.fsu.edu, select secure apps, and then select FSUID Identity Management. Your FSUID is what you use to sign in to your myFSU portal.)

Initial Card:

- There is no cost for your initial **FSUCard**. A \$10 card term fee is assessed semi-annually on the basis of \$5 each for Fall and Spring semesters to all main campus students. This fee is included with your tuition and other student fees at the beginning of each semester.

Replacement Card(s):

- \$15.00 which can be paid at the time of replacement or billed to your student financial services account. NOTE: There is no charge for legal name changes or replacement of stolen **FSUCards** when proper documentation is presented.
