SPECIALIZED STUDIES PROGRAM IN MUSIC OF THE AMERICAS

The Center for Music of the Americas offers a specialized studies program which encourages the research and performance of music of North, South, Central America, and the Caribbean.

Students applying for the Specialized Studies Program in Music of the Americas must meet one of the following requirements:

- a) Be a registered degree-seeking graduate student in the FSU College of Music

Required coursework must be completed within a period of four years or eight semesters of study. Students must maintain a 3.0 grade point average. A total of six (6) credits (equivalent to FSU coursework) may be transferred from an accredited institution.
