



## APPLICATION FOR SPECIALIZED STUDIES PROGRAM IN EARLY MUSIC

A student may complete the Specialized Studies Program in Early Music after successfully finishing the following requirements. The student must be a registered degree-seeking graduate student in the College of Music. Interested students may be asked to demonstrate an intermediate level of performance ability on an early instrument (e.g. recorder, viol, Baroque oboe, Baroque violin, lute, etc.). Required coursework must be completed within a period of five years or ten semesters of study. A minimum 3.0 GPA must be maintained. A total of six (6) credits (equivalent to FSU coursework) may be transferred from an accredited institution. You must make an advising appointment with Dr. Sarah Eyerly ([severly@fsu.edu](mailto:severly@fsu.edu)) to begin the program.
