A student may complete the Specialized Studies Program in Early Music after successfully finishing the following requirements. The Center for Music of the Americas offers a specialized studies program which encourages the research and performance of music of North, South, Central America, and the Caribbean. Students applying for the Specialized Studies Program in Early Music must be registered degree-seeking graduate students in the FSU College of Music. Required coursework must be completed within a period of five years or ten semesters of study. Students must maintain a 3.0 GPA. A total of six (6) credits (equivalent to FSU coursework) may be transferred from an accredited institution.
