



APPLICATION FOR SPECIALIZED STUDIES PROGRAM IN PIANO PEDAGOGY

Admission to the Specialized Studies Program in Piano Pedagogy requires an entry audition. For graduate students, this audition must be at the level of a sophomore performance major.

Special requirements for all students:

The research project will be in addition to any required coursework to meet other degree requirements.

Special requirements for non - performance majors:

A recital program 30 minutes in length will be required, with performance level that of a junior piano major or senior piano principal. The program may be in the form of a studio recital, special recital, or may be performed for a faculty committee.
